

The Corporation of the Township of Wollaston

By-Law 90-09

Being a by-law repealing By-Law 9-81, to prohibit or regulate within the Municipality of the Township of Wollaston, noises likely to disturb the inhabitants thereof;

WHEREAS Section 129 of the Municipal Act 2001 provides that without limiting sections 9, 10 and 11, a local municipality may prohibit and regulate with respect to noise, vibration, odour, dust and outdoor illumination, The Council of Wollaston Township enacts as follows:

That no person or corporation shall cause, permit or allow within the Township of Wollaston, between the hours of 11:00pm to 6:00am, any noise likely to disturb the inhabitants thereof, including, but not limited to, the constant barking of dogs, squealing tires, machine and vehicular noise.

That the time referred to in this by-law shall be Eastern Standard Time when the time in effect or commonly observed in the Township of Wollaston is Eastern Standard Time; when the time in effect or commonly observed in the Township of Wollaston is other than Eastern Standard Time, the time referred to in this by-law shall be reckoned in accordance with the time so commonly observed or in effect in the Township of Wollaston and not Eastern Standard Time.

That any person or corporation who contravenes any of the provisions of this by-law is guilty of an offence and shall, upon conviction, be liable for a fine as provided under the provisions of the Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O. 1990.

That this By-Law shall come into force and take effect immediately upon the passing thereof by the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Wollaston.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 30th day of November, 2009.
